#### 14.9.2024 - DAY 1 :-

- Arrival at Shiraz Shahid Dastgheib International Airport (SYZ). Meet and greet with our tour manager
- Check in Shiraz hotel
- Visit **Vakil Bazaar** (the main bazaar of Shiraz, Iran, located in the historical centre of the city)
- Late lunch/early dinner and rest (overnight in Shiraz)

#### 15.9.2024 - DAY 2 :-

- Breakfast at hotel, meet and greet our local tour guide
- Sightseeing at Pink Mosque (The Nasir al-Mulk Mosque, also known as the Pink Mosque, is a traditional mosque in Shiraz, Iran. It was built during Qajar dynasty rule of Iran. The mosque includes extensive colored glass in its facade, and displays other traditional elements).
- Sightseeing at **Eram Garden** (A historic Persian garden in Shiraz, Iran. The garden, and the building within it, are located at the northern shore of the Khoshk River in the Fars province and belongs to Zand era in 18 century)
- Lunch break
- Sightseeing at **Karim Khan Citadel** (is a citadel located in downtown Shiraz, Iran. It was built as part of a complex during the Zand dynasty. It is named after Karim Khan, and served as his living quarters. It is rectangular in shape and resembles a medieval fortress)
- Dinner and rest (overnight in Shiraz)

#### 16.9.2024 - DAY 3 :-

- Breakfast and checkout from hotel
- Move to **Persepolis** (gate of all nations. Persepolis was the ceremonial capital of the Achaemenid Empire. It is situated in the plains of Marvdasht, encircled by southern Zagros mountains. The earliest remains of Persepolis date back to 515 BC).
- Lunch break
- Sightseeing at **Pasargadae** (was the earliest capital of the Achaemenid (First Persian) Empire. The city was created by Cyrus the Great with contributions from the different peoples who comprised the first great multicultural empire in Western Asia. The archaeological remains of its palaces and garden layout as well as the tomb of Cyrus constitute an outstanding example of the first phase of the evolution of royal Achaemenid art and architecture, and an exceptional testimony to the Achaemenid civilisation in Persia). Continue journey to Yazd and check in hotel in Yazd
- Dinner and rest (overnight in Yazd)

#### 17.9..2024 - DAY 4 :-

Breakfast

- Sightseeing at **Dowlat Abad Garden** (240 years old historical garden in Yazd, Iran. It has wind-catcher is the tallest adobe-made wind-catcher in the world)
- Sightseeing at **Zoroastrian fire temple** (is the place of worship for the followers of Zoroastrianism, the ancient religion of Iran Persia in the Zoroastrian religion)
- Sightseeing at **Jameh Mosque** in Yazd (is the grand, congregational mosque of Yazd city, within the Yazd Province of Iran)
- Lunch break
- Shopping at Termeh shop (traditional handicraft from Yazd province), continue sightseeing at **Amir Chakhmaq Complex** (historical mosque & bazaar)
- Dinner and rest (overnight in Yazd)

#### 18.9.2024 - DAY 5 :-

- Breakfast and checkout hotel
- Move to Esfahan and visit **Naryn Castle** (A mud-adobe fort or castle in the town of Meybod, Iran. Built some 2,000 to 6,000 years ago, it has four towers and stands 40 meters high and contained a plumbing system)
- Check in Esfahan hotel
- Sightseeing at **Si-o-se-pol bridge** (the largest of the eleven historical bridges on the Zayandeh rood, the largest river of the Iranian Plateau)
- Dinner and rest (overnight in Esfahan)

#### 19.9.2024 - DAY 6 :-

- Breakfast
- Visit **Chehel Sotoun Palace** (is a Persian pavilion in the middle of a park at the far end of a long pool, in Isfahan, Iran, built by Shah Abbas II in 16 centuries to be used for his entertainment and receptions)
- Sightseeing at Naqsh-e Jahan Square, including Shah Mosque (standing in south side of Imam Square-built during Safavid period) and Ali Qapu Palace (located on western side of Imam Square)
- Lunch break
- Sightseeing at Esfahan Grand Bazaar and shopping
- Dinner and rest at hotel (overnight in Esfahan)

#### 20.9.2024 - DAY 7 :-

- Breakfast and checkout hotel
- Move to Tehran and visit **Abyaneh Village** (one of the oldest village in Iran, the house building are made of peculiar reddish hue and Abyanaki woman still wearing white long scarf with colorful pattern an under-knee skirt)
- Lunch break
- Continue to Tehran
- Dinner and rest (overnight in Tehran)

#### 21.9.2024 - DAY 8 :-


- Having breakfast at hotel
- Visit **Golestan Palace main hall** (also transliterated as the Gulistan Palace and sometimes translated as the Rose Garden Palace from Persian language, was built in the 16th century)

- Visit **Azadi Tower** (The tower is about 45 metres (148 ft) tall and is completely clad in cut marble. It was commissioned by Mohammad Reza Pahlavi, the last Shah of Iran, to mark the 2,500-year celebration of the Persian Empire and completed in 1971)

- Visit **Milad Tower** (also known as the Tehran Tower, is a multi-purpose tower in Tehran, Iran. It is the sixth-tallest tower and the 24th-tallest freestanding structure in the world)
- Dinner and rest at hotel (overnight in Tehran)

- Move to Imam Khomeini International Airport (IKA) and farewell to our tour guide
